Valle Club memberships are now on sale. Under this membership, you can obtain a permit to hike, mountain bike, fish, ride your horse*, prospect, or camp at our designated campsites. The cost of these membership permits is based on how many people you have on your permit. No firearms, ATVs, or motorcycles are allowed on the property. Four-wheel drives, SUV's, trucks, etc., are allowed on roads to reach designated camping areas only.

* A copy of your negative Coggins test is required in advance for horse people.

Fishing

Our fishing season runs from March 1st through Sept. 30, 2003. There will be no daily fishing permits issued except to those who come as guests of seasonal permit holders and they must be accompanied by those seasonal holders.

Camping for fishermen is restricted to Lake Mina area only. Missouri Conservation rules and limits apply at our lakes.

Hiking, Mountain Biking, and Horseback Riding

Many of our trails have been reopened and repaired. Hiking, mountain biking, and horse trail riding may be done by seasonal or by daily permit, all of which require signed permits first. Parking for these recreations will be provided across the road from the field office. Rates are as follows:

These permits do NOT allow you to hunt game.

Seasonals:

1 Person\$35.00 3 People\$80.00 2 People\$60.00 4 People or more, add \$20.00 per person.

Trails and recreation shuts down for Spring turkey season. Spring turkey season this year is available from the Dept. of Conservation website.

Other special permits

Spring mushroom permits are \$5.00 a day per person or \$25.00 a season and at designated areas only. Other special permits may be available by calling the superintendent.
